21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legisla-
22 ture do not become effective until 90 days after ad-
23 journment unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, the Maine Vocational Development Commis-
25 sion is necessary to carry out training programs for
26 the benefit of the business and economic development
27 of the State; and

28 Whereas, in order to carry out its functions in a
29 proper and timely manner, an appropriation to the
30 Maine Vocational Development Commission is immediat-
31 ly necessary; and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
33 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
34 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
35 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
2 therefore,

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropri-
6 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
7 of this Act.

12 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited
13 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
14 proved.

15 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill makes a \$100,000 appropriation to the
17 Maine Vocational Development Commission for each fis-
18 cal year in the biennium.
