14	11. Automobile salesman. "Automobile salesman"
15	means a person who is primarily engaged in selling
16	automobiles or trucks as an employee of an establish-
17	ment primarily engaged in the business of selling
18	these vehicles to the ultimate purchaser.
19	12. Automobile mechanic. "Automobile mechanic"
20	means a person who is primarily engaged in the ser-
21	vicing of automobiles or trucks as an employee of an
22	establishment primarily engaged in the business of
23	selling automobiles or trucks to the ultimate pur-
24	chaser, except when the employee is paid by the em-
25	ployer on an hourly basis.'
26	Further amend the bill by inserting at the begin-
27	ning of the first line after the enacting clause
28	(page 1, line 22 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 2.'
29	Further amend the bill in the first paragraph af-
30	ter the amending clause in the last line (page 2,
31	line 15 in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined
32	word " <u>salesmen</u> " the underlined word ' <u>automobile</u> '
