STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is intended to clarify the effect of the Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 2851. It makes it clear that innkeepers cannot refuse to rent rooms to, or provide provisions for, any person solely because of where that person may live. It prevents the practice, currently conducted by some Maine hotels and motels, of refusing to rent rooms to local residents.

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
