17 AN ACT to Clarify the Definition of a
18 Vocational Region.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §8301, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1983,
23 c. 485, §26, is further amended to read:

24 5. Vocational region. A vocational region is
25 comprised of all the school administrative units
26 within the geographical boundaries established in
27 section 8451. A region shall be governed by a coop-
28 erative board formed in accordance with section 8452.
29 A region is a school administrative unit responsible
30 for providing vocational education to secondary stu-
31 dents within the region.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill clarifies the purpose and organization-
3 al status of the vocational region as a
4 state-approved unit of school administration. This
5 change is necessary to make clear that a vocational
6 region is an administrative unit because the binding
7 laws as they cross reference throughout the Revised
8 Statutes, Title 20-A refer to the term administrative
9 unit and it is also necessary to establish the com-
10 fort of law to clarify the authority to issue bonds.

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
