Posting signs. There shall be posted in 32 conspicuous places, a sufficient number of signs pro-33 hibiting smoking. The letters in the sign shall be 34 35 at least 1 1/2 inches high and proportionately wide. 36 Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1684." in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 21 37

Clarifies the language regarding exceptions to the smoking prohibition; 7 8 2. Amends the language to ensure that the owner 9 or employer is not responsible for the enforcement of 10 this law; and 11 3. Deletes the specific language which must be on the sign to allow individual stores more flexibil-12 ity.
