1	§1682. Smoking to be prohibited in retail stores
2 3	1. Prohibition. Smoking shall be prohibited in all sections of retail stores.
4 5 6 7 8 9	2. Exceptions. A retail store is exempt from this chapter if the total area open to the public does not exceed 4,000 square feet. Private offices or work areas not generally open to the public may be designated "no smoking," "smoking permitted" or sectioned into different areas at the discretion of the employer or responsible person or persons in charge.

12 13 14 15	1. Persons responsible. The person actually in charge of the operation of the establishment is responsible for implementation of and compliance with this chapter.
