17 AN ACT to Authorize Unemployment Compensation
18 for School Bus Drivers during Summer
19 Vacations.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1192, sub-§7, ¶A, as amended by
24 PL 1977, c. 585, §2, is further amended to read:

25 A. With respect to weeks of unemployment begin-
26 ning after December 31, 1977, in an instruction-
27 al, research or principal administrative capacity
28 for an educational institution, benefits shall
29 not be paid based on such services for any week
30 of unemployment commencing during the period be-
31 tween 2 successive academic years or terms, or
32 when an agreement provides instead for a similar
33 period between 2 regular but not successive
34 terms, during such period, or during a period of
35 paid sabbatical leave provided for in the
36 individual's contract, to any individual if such

1 individual performs such services in the first of
2 such academic years or terms, and if there is a
3 contract or annual written reasonable assurance
4 that such individual will perform services in any
5 such capacity for any educational institution in
6 the 2nd of such academic years or terms. This
7 paragraph does not only apply to school bus driv-
8 ers. They are eligible to receive benefits dur-
9 ing the periods specified in this paragraph;

10 Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §1192, sub-§7, ¶C, as amended by
11 PL 1977, c. 585, §2, is further amended to read:

12 C. With respect to weeks of unemployment begin-
13 ning after December 31, 1977, benefits shall be
14 denied to any individual for any week which com-
15 mences during an established and customary vaca-
16 tion period or holiday recess if such individual
17 performs any services described in ~~paragraphs~~
18 paragraph A or B in the period immediately before
19 such vacation period or holiday recess, and there
20 is annual written reasonable assurance that such
21 individual will perform any such services in the
22 period immediately following such vacation period
23 or holiday recess. This paragraph does not apply
24 to school bus drivers. They are eligible to re-
25 ceive benefits during the periods specified in
26 this paragraph; and

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 This bill allows school bus drivers to receive
29 unemployment compensation between academic years.

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
