IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
AN ACT to Authorize Unemployment Compensation for School Bus Drivers during Summer Vacations.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1192, sub-§7, ¶A, as amended by PL 1977, c. 585, §2, is further amended to read:</pre>
A. With respect to weeks of unemployment beginning after December 31, 1977, in an instructional, research or principal administrative capacity for an educational institution, benefits shall not be paid based on such services for any week of unemployment commencing during the period between 2 successive academic years or terms, or when an agreement provides instead for a similar period between 2 regular but not successive terms, during such period, or during a period of paid sabbatical leave provided for in the individual's contract to any individual if such

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	individual performs such services in the first of such academic years or terms, and if there is a contract or annual written reasonable assurance that such individual will perform services in any such capacity for any educational institution in the 2nd of such academic years or terms. This paragraph does not only apply to school bus drivers. They are eligible to receive benefits during the periods specified in this paragraph;

With respect to weeks of unemployment beginning after December 31, 1977, benefits shall be denied to any individual for any week which commences during an established and customary vacation period or holiday recess if such individual performs any services described in paragraphs paragraph A or B in the period immediately before such vacation period or holiday recess, and there is annual written reasonable assurance that such individual will perform any such services in the period immediately following such vacation period or holiday recess. This paragraph does not apply to school bus drivers. They are eligible to receive benefits during the periods specified in this paragraph; and
