The commander shall be assisted by a Deputy State Ar-ea Command Commander, who shall be qualified in cordance with section 107 and not hold a grade above Brigadier General, and who shall not be the Deputy

10 Adjutant General.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes an additional Maine Army National Guard Brigadier General position as Deputy, STARC, State Area Command Commander. Before authority may be requested for this position from the United States Department of the Army, it must be authorized by state law. Since the State Area Command concept originated 2 years ago, many states have established this position to accomplish premobilization and postmobilization functions. This position would be filled by a part-time National Guard officer, which is something we have not been able to do in the past since the Adjutant General and Deputy Adjutant General, Director, Military Bureau, are both full-time positions.
