17 AN ACT Concerning Eligibility to Apply for a
18 Moose Hunting Permit.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981,
23 c. 118, §2, is amended to read:

24 5. Eligibility. Any Except as provided in this
25 subsection, any Maine resident, nonresident or alien
26 who is eligible to obtain a Maine hunting license is
27 eligible to apply for a moose hunting permit. No
28 person who has obtained a moose hunting permit may
29 apply again for another permit until one year has
30 elapsed since the issuance of the last permit. This
31 limitation shall not apply to subpermittees.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires any person who has obtained a moose hunting permit to wait one year before becoming eligible to apply for another permit. This limitation shall not apply to subpermittees.

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
