20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7054 is enacted to read:

23 §7054. Antipoaching program

24 The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
25 shall operate an antipoaching program, commonly
26 called "Operation Game Thief," in the following man-
27 ner.

28 1. Toll-free line. The department shall main-
29 tain and man, during normal working hours, a
30 toll-free line in order to take calls from citizens
31 concerning violations of fish and wildlife regula-
32 tions.
