- B. The use of the pesticides authorized by this section does not require any approval of the Board of Pesticides Control, nor does it require a solid waste disposal permit from the Department of Environmental Protection.
  - C. No sprayer may apply the pesticide authorized under this section unless he is licensed by the Board of Pesticides Control.
  - D. The municipalities chosen by the Board of Pesticides Control shall bear the cost of purchase and application of the pesticide authorized under this section.
- 2. State funds for research. In the event that any state funds are appropriated for research on the blackfly while this section is effective, part or all of these funds shall be used for monitoring the effects of this experimental project upon the blackfly population in the municipalities where the pesticide application authorized by this section is made.
- 3. Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to monitor effects on fish. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall, using existing funds and programs, monitor the effects of the application of the pesticide authorized by this section upon the fish population of the State.
- 4. Effective duration of section. This section is repealed on December 1, 1986.
- 5. Report to energy and natural resources committee. The Board of Pesticides Control shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and natural resources no later than 14 days after the beginning of the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature to be held in 1986 as to the effectiveness, environmental effects and recommendations for lesser or increased future use of the pesticide authorized by this section.
