23	This amendment reduces the minimum length of
24	preparational, professional time from 45 to 30 min-
25 26	utes. It also clarifies that preparational, profes-
27	sional time is to be made available in a consolidated block, not split up through the day; and it clarifies
28	that it is to occur during the normal school day, not
29	before or after.
