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STATEMENT OF FACT

Very frequently teachers, particularly at the elementary level, are assigned duties with students before school, during the entire academic day and after school duties with students, with little or no opportunity for professional planning time. This bill provides professional planning time to all teachers. The report of the Commission on the Status of Education in Maine stated:

"Teachers are called upon to perform many tasks unrelated to classroom teaching during the school day. As a result, they often have insufficient time for thoughtful curriculum preparation, and their classes are interrupted unnecessarily by routine administrative matters. Nonteaching staff can perform these duties and relieve teachers of the burden."

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
