Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Shoreland Zone in some
Municipalities."

Amend the bill in the last line before the State-
ment of Fact (page 1, line 31 in L.D) by inserting
after the underlined word and punctuation "struc-
ture." the following: 'Nothing in this paragraph may
be construed to permit a municipality to regulate,
under this chapter, a structure which is located more
than 250 feet above the normal high water mark.'

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that
regulation of structures abutting a dock, etc., which
is provided for by the original bill, does not extend
to the part of the structure which may be located
above the 250-foot shoreland zone.
