## 2 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the clerk of a municipality where an illegitimate birth occurred to transmit a copy of the birth certificate to the clerk of the municipality where the mother resides. This allows a mother to more easily obtain a copy of her child's birth record for such purposes as school enrollment without having to request the certificate from the municipality where the child was born or from the State.
