7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 194, L.D. 228,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Provide County Commissioner Dis-
9 tricts in Washington County."

10 Amend the bill in section 2, in the 6th para-
11 graph, 6th line (page 3, line 12 in L.D.) by striking
12 out the following: "10%" and inserting in its place
13 the following: '30%'

14 Further amend the bill in section 3, in the 4th
15 line (page 3, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the
16 figure "1" and inserting in its place the figure '3'

17 Further amend the bill in section 3, in the 5th
18 line (page 3, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the
19 following: "1986" and inserting in its place the fol-
20 lowing: '1988'

21 Further amend the bill in section 3, in the 7th
22 line (page 3, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the
23 figure "2" and inserting in its place the figure '1'

24 Further amend the bill in section 3, in the 9th
25 line (page 3, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the
26 figure "3" and inserting in its place the figure '2'

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 This amendment raises the requirement of the ref-
29 erendum size from 10% of the voters in the last gu-
30 bernatorial election to 30%. It also changes the
31 transition process to make it match the expiration of
32 the terms of the current commissioners.
