## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the 5-inch maximum length lobster measurement. This will create a more competitive environment for the marketing of Maine lobsters, lobster meat and other lobster products outside the State. Being the only state to have a maximum size limit on lobsters prohibits Maine lobstermen from engaging in offshore lobstering and deprives them of the opportunity to increase their catch while out-of-state lobstermen utilize our resources for their own profit. It has not been clearly demonstrated or scientifically proven that retention of the 5-inch measure has helped to preserve the source of lobsters or acted as a conservation measure.

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
