COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 201, L.D. 235,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Designate the 3rd Week in October as  
9 Maine Business Women's Week."

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all  
11 of the first 2 lines after the enacting clause (page  
12 1, lines 22 and 23 in L.D.) and inserting in their  
13 place the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §124 is enacted to read:

§124. Maine Business Women's Week'

16

Further amend to bill in section 1, in that part  
17 designated "§123." in the 3rd line from the end (page  
18 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the underline  
19 word "shall" and inserting in its place the under-  
20 lined word 'may'

Further amend to bill in section 2, subsection 7,  
22 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 3 in L.D.) by striking  
23 out the underlined figure "123" and inserting in its  
24 place the underlined figure '124'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent a  
27 conflict between 2 bills, both of which enact the  
28 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, section 123, and to  
29 remove the requirement that the Department of Educa-
