18 19 20	AN ACT Relating to Legislative Plate Assignments Under the Motor Vehicle Laws.
21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
24 25 26	Whereas, legislative reapportionment of 1983 pro- vided for the first time for 151 numerically desig- nated House of Representative districts; and
27 28 29 30 31	Whereas, it is necessary to correct an inconsis- tency in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, sec- tion 193, to allow that House of Representative plate assignments bear the district number represented by each member; and
32 33 34	Whereas, it is necessary to provide for desig- nated plates for members of legislative leadership; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 29 MRSA §193, as amended by PL 1977, c. 78, §166,
10 is further amended to read:

11 §193. State officials

The Secretary of State shall, upon payment of the 12 13 required in sections 109 and 242, subsection 1, fees 14 paragraph A and application therefor, by Maine Mem-15 bers of the United States Senate, Maine Members of 16 the United States House of Representatives, Members 17 of the Legislature, Representatives of the Indian 18 Tribes at the Legislature, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Secretary of the Senate and, 19 Clerk of the House, Majority Leader, Assistant Major-20 ity Leader, Minority Leader and Assistant Minority 21 Leader of the House of Representatives and the Senate 22 23 issue one pair of specially designed number plates 24 for one designated motor vehicle owned or controlled 25 by each of the officials named. Upon request by a 26 Maine Member of the United States Senate or by а 27 Maine Member of the United States House of Represen-28 tatives, the Secretary of State shall issue an addi-29 tional pair of specially designed number plates for a 30 2nd designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by 31 Such specially designed plates and that member. 32 their accompanying registration certificate shall be issued to, and used by, the named officials in lieu 33 34 the regular plates and registration provided for of in section 110 at the option of the named officials. 35 any of the named officials shall choose to apply 36 If 37 for a motor vehicle registration and plates as prescribed in section 110, and also request in addition 38 39 to the regular registration and plates, that he or she be issued an additional set of specially designed 40 plates together with their accompanying certificates 41 of registration, the Secretary of State shall upon 42

1 receipt of application and the payment of a fee of \$2 2 issue such special plates and registration certificate for such motor vehicle that is currently regis-3 4 tered and assigned regular registration plates. Any 5 specially designed number plates issued to any of the 6 named officials shall be valid only during the term 7 office for which the registrant is elected. In of case the office is for any cause vacated during 8 said 9 term, such special number plates and registration 10 certificate shall be immediately surrendered to the 11 Secretary of State.

12 The color, shape, size, lettering and numbering 13 of the special plates shall be determined by the Sec-14 retary of State, except the plates issued to Members 15 of the House of Representatives, other than the Speaker of the House, shall bear the number 16 of the 17 seat assigned to such House District represented by 18 each member, and except the plates issued to the Mem-19 bers of the Senate, except the President of the Sen-20 ate, shall bear the number of the Senatorial District 21 which the respective Senators represent.

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited 23 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-24 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the plate assignment for members of the House of Representatives from the number of the seat assigned to the number of the House District each member represents. This bill also allows for specially designed legislative plates for the Majority and Minority floor leaders of the House of Representatives and Senate.
