17 AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by the
18 University of New England in Biddeford.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 P&SL 1953, c. 123, §4 is enacted to read:

23 Sec. 4. Additional degree granting powers. The
24 corporation, formerly known as St. Francis College,
25 now known as the University of New England, in addi-
26 tion to the powers already granted to it by the Pri-
27 vate and Special Laws 1953, chapter 123, and amended
28 by the Private and Special Laws 1975, chapter 137,
29 may grant and confer through the University of New
30 England the academic degrees of Associate in Arts,
31 Associate in Science, Associate in Applied Science,
32 Master of Arts and Master of Science by the appropri-
33 ate action of its trustees, upon all who satisfacto-
34 rially complete such courses of study as the trustees
35 may prescribe.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to broaden the au-
3 thority of the University of New England to confer
4 degrees.

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
