AN ACT to Modify Inequitable Income  
Eligibility Guidelines in the Elderly  
Householders Tax and Rent Refund  
Act and to Increase Income  
Eligibility to Conform with Other  
Federally Established Poverty Levels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

36 MRSA §6108, as amended by PL 1981, c. 698, §189, is further amended to read:

§6108. Income limitation

No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to claimants of single member households with household income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and \$6,200 \$6,225 in each succeeding the year for which relief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable may be granted to claimants of households of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,700 in ead-
