20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 22 MRSA §680, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
23 345, §§13 and 14, is amended to read:

24 1. Nuclear power plants. The annual registration
25 fee for operating nuclear power plants is \$59,200
26 \$75,000 per year.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The registration fee for operating nuclear power plants is used to support the department environmental surveillance activities around Maine Yankee. The existing fee of \$59,200 was established in 1979 and has not been adjusted for inflation since, while consumer pricing has increased about 40%. An increase to \$75,000 is a 26.7% increase in the fee.

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
