Mountain Brook, and all of the streams and ponds leading into, or tributary to any stream connecting the Fish's and Hobbs' ponds. The authority herein and hereby granted shall also include and give the right to the company to withdraw the water from the ponds, lakes, brooks, rivers and tributaries and for reservoirs or basins that may be constructed for the purposes aforesaid by pipes and aqueducts laid directly therefrom; or by artificial water ways to supply Mirror Lake; also to connect the same with any of 11 the mains of the company. Nothing herein contained may in any way increase or extend the rights of the company in or to the waters of Hobbs', Fish's, Grassy or Rocky Ponds or the tributaries thereof beyond what 14 15 already exist. Nothing herein contained may in any way limit or restrict recreational use of Megunticook 16 Lake and Megunticook River in the Towns of Camden, Lincolnville and Hope; or curtail any such recrea-18 tional use existing on those bodies of water in those 19 20 towns as of the date of enactment of this legisla-21 tion, except an area within 200 feet of an intake 22 pipe as may be necessary for the safety of the pub-23 lic.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1880, c. 212, §2, as amended by PL 1913, c. 185, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Section 2. Powers and duties. The company is authorized to erect and maintain dams upon any or all of the lakes, ponds, brooks, Oyster River and tributaries of the water identified in section 1, for the purpose of creating and maintaining storage basins or reservoirs of water and to flow the land of any riparian proprietor therefore, to erect and maintain reservoirs and lay down and maintain pipes and aqueducts necessary for the proper accumulating, conducting, discharging, distributing and disposing of the water, except that such right to erect and maintain dams shall not extend to and shall not authorize such erection and maintenance of dams on Megunticook Lake Megunticook River in the Towns of Camden, Lincolnville and Hope, and such right to flow the land of any riparian proprietor shall not extend to nor encompass the Megunticook Lake and the Megunticook River.

A. Right of eminent domain and limitation thereon; crossing property of other public utilities. The company is authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase or by the exercise of the right of eminent domain, which right is expressly delegated to the water company for any of its purposes, any lands, rights-of-way, water and water rights, including springs or wells, or any other interest in real estate which may be required for the carrying out of the purposes of the company.

Provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed as authorizing the company to take by right of eminent domain any of the property or facilities of any other public service corporation or district used or acquired for future use by the owner thereof in the performance of a public duty, unless expressly authorized thereto herein or by subsequent act of the Legislature.

In case of any crossing of any public utility, unless consent be given by the company owning or operating such public utility as to place, manner and conditions of the crossing within 30 days after such consent is requested by the corporation, the Public Utilities Commission shall determine the place, manner and conditions of such crossing and all work on the property of such public utility shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of such public utility, but at the expense of the company.

Sec. 3. P&SL 1880, c. 212, §2-A is enacted to read:

Section 2-A. Other rights. Use of the Megunticook Lake and the Megunticook River in the Towns of Camden, Lincolnville, and Hope shall be only for emergency use and as a backup supply of water for the water company, unless other additional use is authorized by subsequent act of the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Existing sources of water supply of the Camden and Rockland Water Company are inadequate to meet the future needs of the inhabitants of Camden, Rockport, Thomaston, So. Thomaston, Owls Head and Rockland. This bill allows the company to access the waters of Megunticook Lake and Megunticook River to provide for uninterrupted and adequate supply of water for human comsumption and fire protection.
