COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 90, L.D. 270,
Bill, "AN ACT to Deorganize Plantation 14."

Amend the Bill in section 3 in the 6th line (page
2, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
"regular March, 1986," and inserting in its place the
words 'next regular'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act:

FISCAL NOTE

Passage of this bill would result in an increase
in revenues of \$38,120 through reimbursement from the
Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund. In
addition, there would be some minor savings as the
State would no longer have to reimburse Plantation 14
under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law and veterans' ex-
emptions beginning in fiscal year 1987.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to remove the
3 reference to the plantation's annual March meeting
4 since this requirement has been removed from the law
5 and to add an appropriation section and a fiscal
