Whereas, Acts of the Legis-lature do not become effective until 90 days after 12 13 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, the lobster industry in the State could 16 suffer serious economic losses if trade in frozen 17 lobster tails is not permitted under proper supervision and regulation; and 18 19 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 20 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 21 the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 22 23 24 therefore, ' 25 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following: 26 '5. Report; repeal. The department shall report in writing to the joint standing committee of the 27 28 29 Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources 30 on the activities conducted under this section. The 31 report shall be submitted no later than January 15, 32 1986. This section shall be repealed on May 1, 1986. 33 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 34 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-35 proved. '

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to attach an 3 emergency to the bill so that it can go into effect 4 prior to the peak of the lobstering season. The 5 amendment also adds a one-year sunset provision and 6 requires the department to report on the activities 7 conducted under the lobster tail permit provisions.
