17 AN ACT Relating to Criminal Offenses on the  
18 Penobscot Reservation.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §6209, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by  
23 PL 1979, c. 732, §1, is repealed and the following  
24 enacted in its place:

25 A. Criminal offenses against a person or proper-  
26 ty which are committed on the Passamaquoddy Indi-  
27 an Reservation by a member of either tribe or na-  
28 tion against another member of either tribe or  
29 nation, against the property of another member of  
30 either tribe or nation for which the maximum po-  
31 tential term of imprisonment does not exceed 6  
32 months and the maximum potential fine does not  
33 exceed \$500 and criminal offenses against a per-  
34 son or property which are committed on the  
35 Penobscot Indian Reservation for which the maxi-  
36 mum potential term of imprisonment does not ex-
