14 15 16	IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
17 18 19	AN ACT to Enable Use of Certain Procedures for Absentee Ballots.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §1254-A is enacted to read:
23 24	§1254-A. Voting in institutions designated by the clerk
25 26 27 28	Upon authorization of the municipal officers, the clerk shall designate certain institutions within the municipality to receive absentee voter assistance as provided in this section.
29 30 31 32 33 34 35	1. Selected institutions. At least 120 days prior to the election for which assistance is to be provided, the clerk shall establish a list of insti- tutions, in which potential absentee voters are con- fined, selected to receive assistance. The clerk may select any institutions he deems appropriate and which agree to accept that assistance.

1 2 3 4 5 6	2. Restrictions. Once institutions have been selected, absentee voting by those confined to it must be in accordance with this section, except for voters who become eligible to cast absentee ballots after assistance has been provided in that institution.
7 8 9 10	3. Procedure. At least 35 days prior to the election, the clerk shall establish a schedule for providing assistance at each institution, the latest date for which shall be 7 days prior to the election.
11 12 13	A. The clerk may accept voter registration applications, subject to final approval by the reg- istrar.
14 15 16 17 18	B. Voting shall be conducted as otherwise pre- scribed in this chapter, except that an applica- tion shall not be required. In municipalities with electronic voting systems, votes may be cast using ballot cards.
19 20 21 22 23	C. The clerk may provide a voting booth and a ballot box. In those cases, the sealed and cer- tified absentee ballot envelope containing the absentee ballot shall be deposited in the ballot box.
24 25 26 27 28	4. Notice. Notice of the list of selected in- stitutions and of the schedule for providing assist- ance shall each be published within 5 days of their establishment in a newspaper having general circula- tion in the municipality.
29	STATEMENT OF FACT
30 31 32 33	The purpose of this bill is to establish a proce- dure to handle absentee balloting in certain munici- pal institutions where potential absentee voters are confined.
