COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 242, L.D. 283,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to Private
9 Investigators."

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Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part design-
nated "§8113." by striking out all of subsection 7
(page 3, lines 7 to 11 in L.D.) and renumbering the
subsections to read consecutively.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment does not change the intent or ef-
fect of the original bill, but clarifies the grounds
for suspension or revocation of a private
investigator's license. The standards of unprofes-
sional conduct, stated as such a ground in subsection
7 of the bill includes only the provisions of the
chapter governing private investigators, the rules
adopted by the Commissioner of Public Safety and the
Criminal Code, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
17-A. This amendment deletes subsection 7 because it
is duplicative since these provisions are already re-
ferred to in subsections 2 and 3.
