15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	This amendment does not change the intent or effect of the original bill, but clarifies the grounds for suspension or revocation of a private investigator's license. The standards of unprofessional conduct, stated as such a ground in subsection 7 of the bill includes only the provisions of the chapter governing private investigators, the rules adopted by the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Criminal Code, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A. This amendment deletes subsection 7 because it is duplicative since these provisions are already referred to in subsections 2 and 3.
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
