STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This increase in the handling fee is necessitated by the increased costs of providing the public with 3 an efficient system for returning beverage contain-4 5 ers. An increase in the statutory fee is a more eq-6 uitable means of covering these costs than a general 7 price increase would be, because the fee always goes 8 to the dealer or redemption center which actually 9 handles the container.

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
