17 AN ACT Concerning Minimum Ordinary Death  
18 Benefits.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 4 MRSA §1355-A, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1983, c.  
23 863, Pt. B, §§31 and 45, is repealed and the follow-  
24 ing enacted in its place:

25 1. Benefit. Notwithstanding any provision of  
26 this Title, any eligible spouse, child or children of  
27 a judge who was in service prior to December 1, 1984,  
28 shall be, upon the death of that judge and regardless  
29 of whether the status of that judge at the time of  
30 his death was in service, on disability retirement or  
31 on service retirement, entitled to a minimum benefit  
32 of the greater of the following:

33 A. One-half of the retirement benefit of that  
34 judge determined in accordance with section 1352  
35 on the assumption that retirement of that judge  
36 had taken place on the date of his death; or
