22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 36 MRSA §311, 2nd ¶, as repealed and replaced by
25 PL 1975, c. 545, §8, is amended to read:

26 Certificates of eligibility shall be renewed an-
27 nually, provided the assessor completes at least 16
28 hours of classroom training approved by the State Tax
29 Assessor each year, except that, in lieu of the annu-
30 al training requirement, any assessor who is 62 years
31 of age or older is required to complete at least 32
32 hours of approved classroom training every 2 years.
