20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as

22 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1121, sub-§7, as amended by PL
23 1975, c. 622, §51, is repealed.

24 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §1125, sub-§2, as repealed and
25 replaced by PL 1965, c. 390, §3, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Section 1 repeals a provision which provided a benefit to spouses and children of sheriffs. This provision has been superseded by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1125, subsection 1-A, which provides a greater benefit to members in the case of death as a result of an injury received in the line of duty.

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Section 2 repeals a provision which assured state police who were not members of the Maine State Retirement System an accidental death benefit. There are no longer any state police who are not members of the Maine State Retirement System. Thus this section of law is meaningless.

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
