17 AN ACT to Revise Rules Governing  
18 Certification of Seed Potatoes.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 7 MRSA §2103-A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 565,  
23 §1, is amended by adding after the first paragraph a  
24 new paragraph to read:

25 Foundation seed potato varieties not available to  
26 Maine growers from the state seed potato farm shall  
27 be exempt from the 5-generation requirement until  
28 such time as the commissioner determines the supply  
29 from the state seed potato farm is adequate.
