22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 20-A MRSA §1405, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL
25 1983, c. 364, §3, is amended to read:

26 B. Instead of a district election, a municipal
27 election shall be conducted and a ~~2/3~~ majority
28 vote of those casting valid ballots in the munic-
29 ipality is required before it may withdraw;
