17 AN ACT Relating to Motorcycle Safety.
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 29 MRSA §1368, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1973, c.
22 58, is amended to read:

23 No vehicles, other than ambulances, fire depart-
24 ment, police department and highway maintenance vehi-
25 cles, ~~shall~~ may be equipped with a device which pro-
26 vides for the alternate flashing of the vehicle head-
27 lamps. Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle shall be
28 equipped with a means of modulating the upper beam of
29 the headlamp between a high and a lower brightness at
30 a rate of 200 to 280 cycles per minute. These head-
31 lamps shall be modulated at all times when the motor-
32 cycle is being operated.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require the use of
3 modulating headlights in motorcycles.

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
