Amend the amendment in that part designated  
"§603-B." in subsection 2, in the 9th line (page 3,  
line 6 in amendment) by inserting after the under-  
lined words "for the" the underlined word 'base'

Further amend the amendment in that part desig-  
nated "§603-B." in subsection 2, in the 12th line  
(page 3, line 9 in amendment) by inserting after the  
underlined word and punctuation "techniques." the  
following: 'Any rules which provide for the limita-  
tion of emissions of sulfur dioxide from specific  
sources in order to achieve the statewide emission  
limitation shall provide that, for facilities which  
produced energy from sources other than fossil fuel  
during the base years, any base year in which the en-  
ergy produced from nonfossil fuel sources exceeded  
the average yearly nonfossil fuel energy produced  
during the base year or production at the facility  
was below the average yearly production during the  
base years, shall be excluded for purposes of impos-  
ing limitations on that source.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of this amendment is to ensure  
3 sources emitting sulfur dioxide by burning oil are  
4 not penalized in the calculation of the base years if  
5 a facility, during one of the base years, utilized  
6 more energy from sources other than oil, such as  
7 hydropower, or had less production than the average  
8 for the remaining base years.
