September 14, 1984, the Legislature enacted a pay raise for state employees as negotiated with the authorized employee representatives. That pay raise provided, in part, for a lump sum retroactive payment to cover the period from July 1, 1983, through July As subsequently interpreted by the execu-1984. tive branch, those retroactive benefits were not provided to a few people who were employed by the State from July 1, 1983, to July 1, 1984, but who left state service prior to the enactment of these retroactive benefits on September 14, 1984. This interpretation is unfair to those few employees who worked for the State during the entire benefit period, who did not receive this retroactive lump sum pay-The intent of this bill is to correct that oversight.
