STATEMENT OF FACT

Under the Chemical Substance Identification Law, Public Law 1984, c. 823, all standards and regulations adopted by the Bureau of Labor Standards under the law must be approved by the Legislature by resolve. The purpose of this resolve is to provide legislative approval for the regulations in order that they may remain in effect.
