7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 108, L.D. 323, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Maine Certificate of Need 9 Act to Define More Clearly the Legal Requirements for 10 Ex Parte Contacts During the Certificate of Need Pro-11 cess, Consistent with of the Maine Administrative 12 Procedure Act."

13 Amend the bill by striking out everything after 14 the enacting clause and inserting in its place the 15 following:

16 '22 MRSA §307, sub-§2-B, ¶J, as enacted by PL 17 1981, c. 705, Pt. V, §25, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

19	J. After a hearing commences, no appointed mem-
20	bers of the committee or the department may com-
21	municate directly or indirectly in connection
22	with any application with any affected party or
23	anyone acting in their behalf, except upon notice
24	and opportunity for all affected parties to par-
25	ticipate. This paragraph shall not prohibit the
26	department from communicating with any affected
27	party or anyone acting on their behalf for the
28	purpose of arranging a public meeting pursuant to
29	paragraph G.
