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The purpose of this bill is to reduce the number of voting booths which a municipality is required to have in a general election. The change from one booth for every 150 voters to one booth for every 215 voters reflects a reduction of approximately 30%. The current requirement is overly costly to municipalities and needlessly creates space problems.

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
