COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 120, L.D. 335,
Bill, "AN ACT to Protect Tenants when Landlords Fail
to Pay Utility Bills."

10 Amend the Bill in that part designated "<u>316.</u>" by 11 striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its 12 place the following:

'2. Disconnection of tenant. In every instance where the landlord has applied for and is granted utility service, the landlord is responsible for pay-13 14 15 16 ment for that service with respect to any rental 17 property. The utility may not demand payment from the 18 tenant for utility service to the tenant because of 19 the landlord's failure to pay for utility service 20 rendered at the rental property. The utility may dis-21 connect the tenant only after affording the tenant 22 notice and opportunity to assume responsibility for future service in accordance with the rules of the 23 24 commission.

Further amend the Bill in that part designated [§316." in subsection 3 in the first line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word [In" and inserting in its place the following: [Notwithstanding section 3225, in]

## STATEMENT OF FACT

31 This amendment makes it clear that the landlord 32 is responsible for payment for utility service when 33 the landlord applies for and is granted that service. 34 Currently, the Public Utilities Commission's discon-35 nect regulations, chapter 81, state the procedure for 36 utilities to follow prior to disconnecting a tenant COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 120, L.D. 335

for the landlord's nonpayment. This amendment ensures that the procedures in that rule would still apply in that situation. There is also a technical amendment to make it clear that the lien provision does apply despite the prohibition of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35, section 3225.
