17 AN ACT Concerning Notice to Wholesalers of
18 Retail Liquor License Transfers.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 28 MRSA §203, sub-§3 is amended to read:

23 3. Guardians and conservators. Duly appointed
24 and qualified guardians and conservators of the es-
25 tate of a licensee may take over, operate and renew
26 licenses of their wards during their term of office,
27 provided they or their managers are approved by the
28 commission, and in all cases, except retail store li-
29 censes approved by the municipal officers in their
30 municipality, they shall have no privilege of trans-
31 ferring their wards' licenses and must renew licenses
32 each year. Penalty for violations shall apply to both
33 guardians or conservators and their managers in the
34 same manner provided in the case of executors or ad-
35 ministrators and their managers. Any sale of stock of
36 a corporate licensee which effects a change of con-

1 trol of the licensed premises shall be considered a
2 transfer within the meaning of this section, and a
3 new license must be purchased and wholesalers of malt
4 and vinous liquors notified of the transfer.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to provide notice to
7 wholesalers of malt and vinous liquors of transfers
8 of licenses.
