18 AN ACT to Amend the Law Concerning Smoke  
19 Detectors in all Multiapartment  
20 Dwellings.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
23 follows:

24 25 MRSA §2464, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1981, c.  
25 399, §1, is amended to read:

26 3. Multiapartment buildings. In multiapartment  
27 buildings more than 3 stories in height, approved  
28 smoke detectors shall also be installed in each  
29 ~~elosed~~ corridor and ~~elosed~~ hallway on each floor.

30 STATEMENT OF FACT

31 It is the opinion of the State Fire Marshal's Of-  
32 fice that in the interest of public safety, smoke de-

1     tectors should be installed in all corridors and  
2     hallways of multiapartment buildings, regardless of  
3     whether the corridors or hallways are closed. This  
4     bill will accomplish that result.

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
