2 STATEMENT OF FACT

Current law allows individuals to vote by absentee ballot before the clerk in the clerk's office without completing an application. This bill allows individuals to vote by absentee ballot in the presence of a clerk anywhere without completing an application. Such absentee voting would not be restricted to the clerk's office.

This bill allows clerks, if they wish, to conduct absentee voting in nursing homes and other institutions prior to election day without requiring the residents of such institutions to complete applications for absentee ballots.
