20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §53, sub-§5, as enacted by PL
23 1975, c. 741, §4, is amended to read:

24 5. Wine and spirits for sale. To buy and have in
25 their possession wine, except table wine, and spirits
26 for sale to the public. Such wine and spirits shall
27 be purchased by the commission directly and not
28 through the State Purchasing Agent and shall be free
29 from adulteration and misbranding. The commission
30 shall in their purchases of liquors give priority,
31 wherever feasible, to those products manufactured or
32 bottled in this State and shall assure that those
33 products are prominently displayed and positioned in
34 the stores.

35 Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §153, sub-§2 is enacted to read:
