17 AN ACT to Allow all Disabled Veterans and  
18 Those 62 Years of Age to Receive a  
19 \$4,000 Property Tax Exemption.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 36 MRSA §653, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 1975,  
24 c. 550, §1, is further amended to read:

25 C. The estates up to the just value of \$4,000,  
26 having a taxable situs in the place of residence,  
27 of veterans who served in the Armed Forces of the  
28 United States during any federally recognized war  
29 period, including the Korean Campaign and the  
30 Viet Nam War, when they shall have reached the  
31 age of 62 years or when they are receiving any  
32 form of pension or compensation from the United  
33 States Government for total disability, service-  
34 connected or nonservice-connected, as a veteran.  
35 The exemption provided in this paragraph shall  
36 apply to the property of such veteran including

1 property held in joint tenancy with his or her  
2 spouse.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 The purpose of this bill is to allow all disabled  
5 veterans and all veterans 62 years of age or older to  
6 receive a \$4,000 property tax exemption.
