SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 133, L.D. 372,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Licensing of Companies
Who Apply Pesticides as Custom or Commercial Applica-
tors."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are al-
located from revenues dedicated to the Board of Pes-
ticides Control as follows:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an increase in dedicated
revenue of \$21,500 annually. This estimate is based
on the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Re-
sources anticipating that 215 commercial pesticides
application companies would pay the \$100 license fee.
These dedicated revenues will be allocated to the De-
partment of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources'
Board of Pesticides Control.'
