## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase voter turnout. The bill makes the day of the statewide general election a state holiday. It is currently a legal holiday and courts are closed and county offices may be closed. The bill requires the Governor to issue a proclamation encouraging voters to vote on that day.
